Disciple-Maker's Character

Christ-centered: living from your identity in Christ rather than your 'fleshly' self

Read Ephesians 1:3-23

-Describe how you see yourself from a 'worldly' or fleshly perspective. Why?

-From the above verses (& others you know) what does Jesus say who you are in Him?

-In your own words, what does it mean to live a Christ-centered life? Give an example.

Disciple-Maker's Life Skills

Praying Effectively: Motivated to pray because you receive the Father's answers.

Read John 14:12-14; 15:7-11,16; 16:23-24,26-27 Compared to John 17

-What are some of the truths that Jesus is teaching about prayer in the above verses?

-How would you describe what prayer is in your own words? Why is prayer important?

-What makes praying difficult? What encourages you in your prayer life?

Accountability & Prayer Break into smaller groups (men & women)

Creating a safe environment to be vulnerable, honest & accountable to each other.

-Share one thing you would like the group to pray for you this week.

-Pray for each other.

MISSIONAL LIVING ...

Encouraging each other to serve people inside and outside the walls of Rockpoint.

Living as Fishers of Men: Share who you are praying for where you live, work & play that our Father would bring to personally trust Jesus to save and change their lives.

Rockpoint Missionary: Pray for your Rockpoint missionary.

Sermon Discussion *Use the following application questions from the sermon.*

As you listened to the message, what thought did our Father impress upon you as to how to apply this message to your life? Why?

Big Idea: God's Complete Plan for Faith at Home. We so often miss the disciple-making call God has given his people from the beginning, for all of life, being the arenas we love God and love others. To do that requires the pieces of three generations following Jesus together.

Read Deuteronomy 6:4-9 *What questions did you think of as you read these verses?*

⁴Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. ⁵You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. ⁶And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. ⁷You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. ⁸You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ⁹You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

-What does Jesus' promise of an abundant life mean to you?

-How strongly do you really believe that our Father has only good for you? Explain.

FAITH AT HOME... Whatever your 'home' is, the place where you live, work and play... family, friends, neighbors, co-workers, strangers... every season of life.

-Describe the people who are in your 'home.'

*-Who are some of the people in your 'home' that the Father is leading you to disciple?
(Note: discipling begins with helping someone who doesn't yet know Jesus in a personal way make the decision to repent of sin & trust Jesus to save them.)*
