## Getting Started:

  - c. Does it make Peter's words more or less critical and why?
2. Read 1 Peter 2:1 – 12 and answer the following questions:
  - a. How does Peter call us to be People of the book? As you look at your own life and our church, how does this encourage you and challenge you?
  - b. How does Peter call us to be People of Transformation? As you look at your own life and our church, how does this encourage you and challenge you?
  - c. How does Peter call us to be People engaged in Worship? As you look at your own life and our church, how does this encourage you and challenge you?

d. How does Peter call us to be People living out the Kingdom? As you look at your own life and our church, how does this encourage you and challenge you?

e. How does Peter call us to be People on Mission? As you look at your own life and our church, how does this encourage you and challenge you?

3. Read 2 Corinthians 5:18 – 21.

a. How are we reconciled to God?

b. What “ministry” are we given? What is our mission (verse 20)?  
(cf. Matthew 28:18 – 20).

**Taking it home:**

1. How do these passages personally challenge you?

2. What are you most excited about as you read our Vision 2020 plan?

3. How does our Vision 2020 plan personally inspire you to get involved at Rockpoint and in our community?
